Christian Community Churches New Zealand, through its Auckland Regional Enabler network (Auckland Partnership Affiliated [APA]), invites applications for the part-time role of Mission Enabler, currently remunerated for up to 3 days per week.

The position is Auckland-based. It requires a person of experience with significant leadership and mission competencies together with a vision to strengthen existing and initiate new Christian outreach.

Demonstrable evangelical Christian convictions, a heart for evangelism, and a capacity to both inspire and communicate effectively to diverse church leaders, colleagues, teams, and non-Christians is essential.

Together with facilitation and mobilisation responsibilities, the role requires spiritual discernment and maturity, teaching and pastoral gifts, and the grace to work irenically within potentially conflictual contexts, to harmonise and not polarise.

The role will require some business acumen as Auckland's unitary plan is an important consideration in the establishment of this position.

A sense that this is a calling from God, is endorsed by others (including church leaders), and is a committed faith step is important.

Any applicant, whether from a CCCNZ context or not, should be closely identified with, sympathetic to, and committed to the faith, vision, and aspirations of Christian Community Churches, NZ.
