

CHILD PROTECTION WORKSHOP

A short, targeted course designed to help churches and ministries develop robust child protection policies, awareness and best practice in caring for vulnerable people.



Chief Executive of Child Matters, Jane Searle, will provide introductory level information about specific child protection related subjects, such as the different categories of child abuse and providing the skills, knowledge and confidence to identify and respond to a child within our churches who may be at risk.

The workshop will also cover why a Child Protection Policy is essential for any church and reducing risk factors for the vulnerable in our church communities regarding abuse.

These workshops will also include Q&A time, as well as follow up webinars to address any ongoing queries raised from the event.

PRESENTER

Jane Searle is the Chief Executive of Child Matters and also attends Northgate Community Church. Jane previously qualified as a barrister and solicitor practicing criminal and family law. Jane then joined the NZ Police where she worked on the Child Abuse Team after qualifying as a detective. Jane has also worked as a Counter Fraud Specialist in the UK, where she headed a team of investigators responsible for fraud detection and investigation. After returning to New Zealand Jane worked as a trainer for local government, financial institutions, insurance companies and the health sector before joining Child Matters in July 2015.
