
























B3: This local church is resourcing my spiritual journey well






B5: I appreciate the music






B7: I feel a sense of God's presence






B9: I am being challenged to take action






B11: How satisfied are you with what is offered here for youth aged 12-18 years?




B13: If you have children under the age of 12, how many ...






B15: Do you have children who attend a Church/Christian school?










D2: Do you believe that Christians have a responsibility to actively care for the environment?
















E3: How much do you participate in the activities of this local church, compared to before COVID-19?






E5: About how much do you give financially to this congregation?






F2: How confident are you that this local church can achieve the vision, goals or directions it has set for itself?




F3: How important is it to you that this local church is part of this denomination(s)?








F7: This local church is inclusive of different kinds of people






F9: It is easy to get involved in ministry at this local church (eg join a roster, take on a role)






F11: The leaders in this local church are willing to support new initiatives


