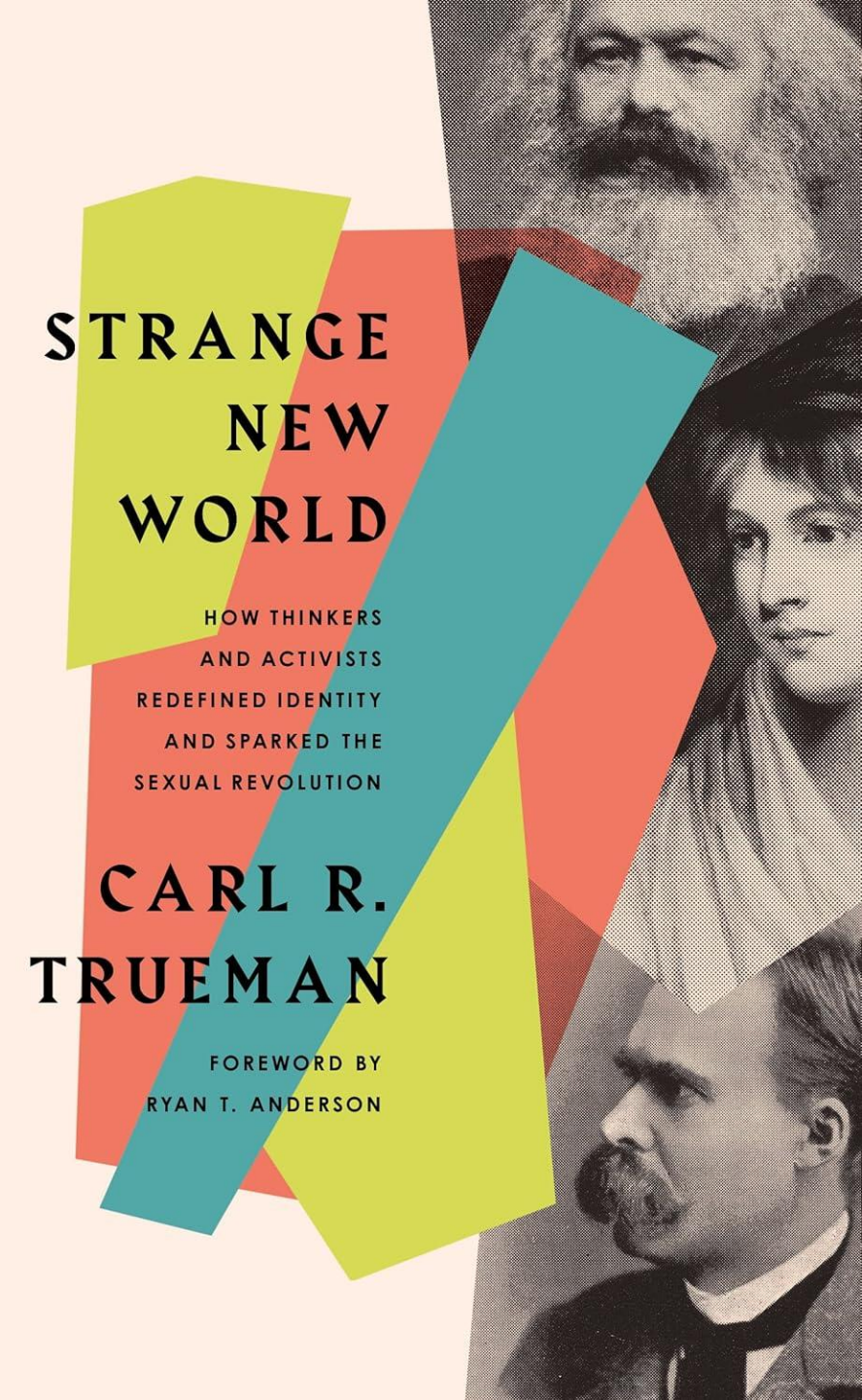

- Written by Australian scholars, and one Kiwi.

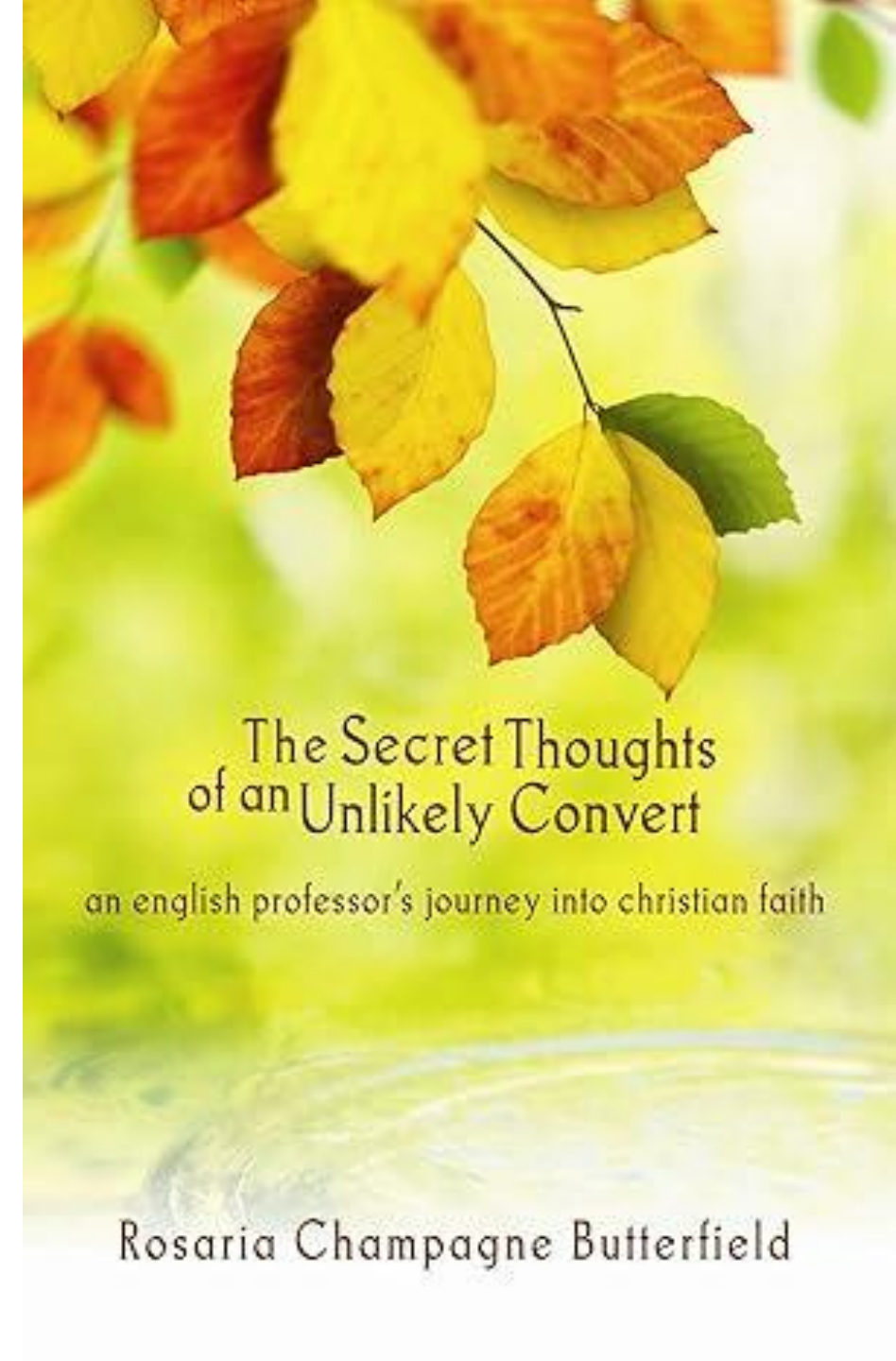
