- Has also written a much bigger and more robust version: *Rise and Triumph of the Modern Self*.

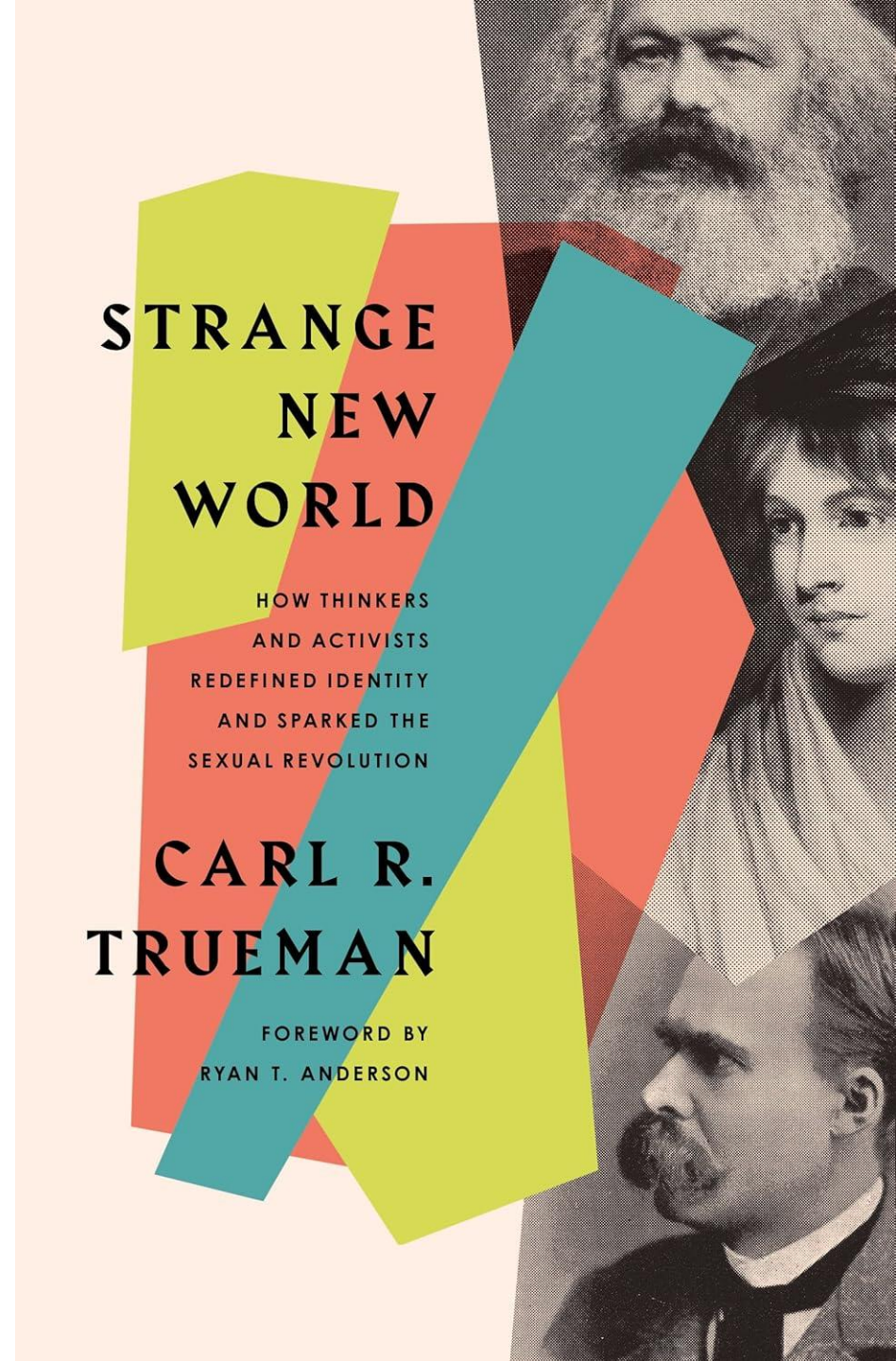

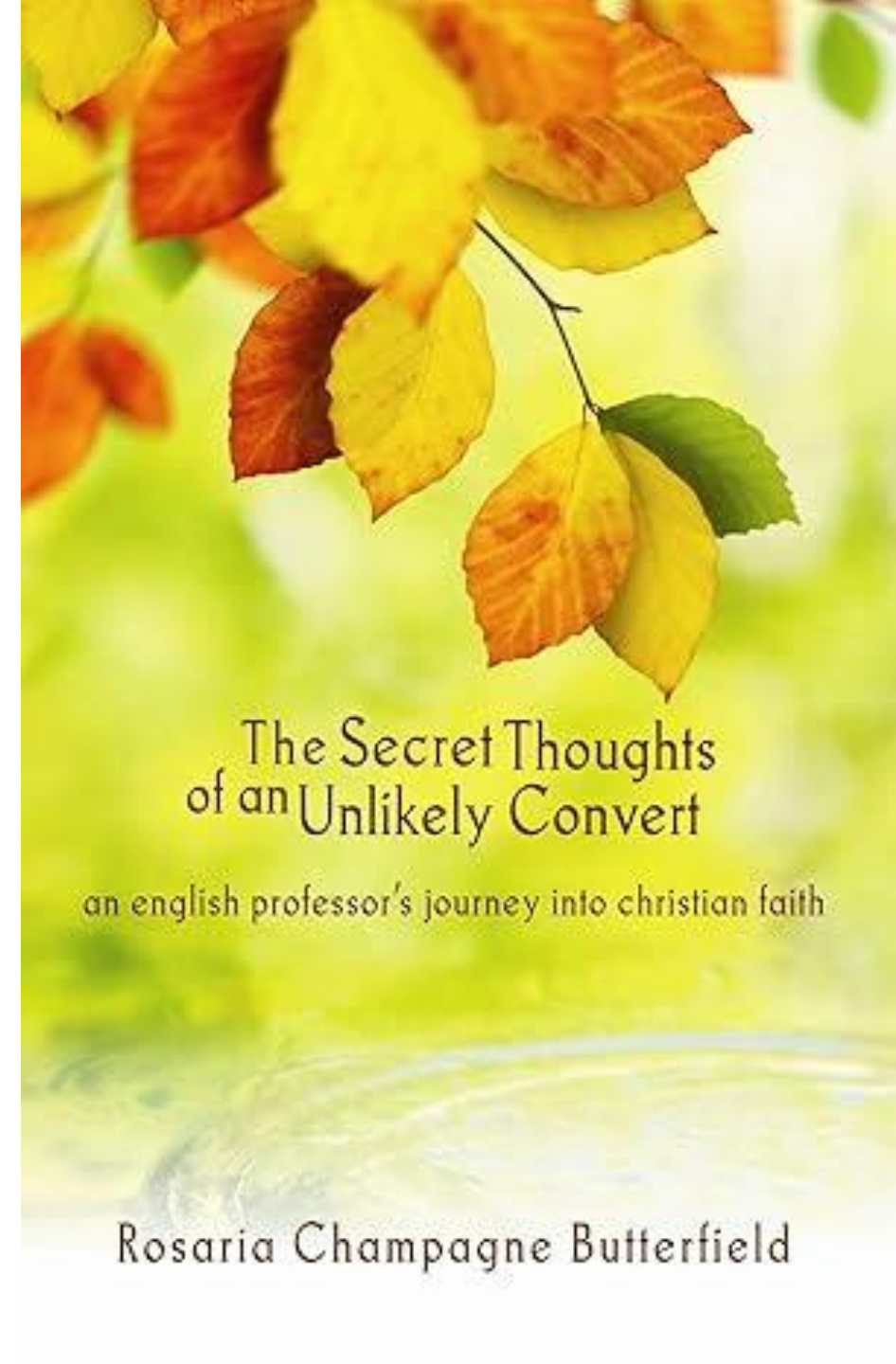
