


Prayer Journey at PGC





One of PGC's goals for 2025, is to encourage the church toward more “prayer awareness and to develop a greater awareness as to what God is doing “in us” and “outside our walls”.



Examples of how PGC has encouraged prayer awareness of what God is doing “in us”

Use of Prayer themes: At our church camp people were invited to select a theme they would like prayer for like Guidance; Forgiveness; Knowing God's peace; Healing etc. Then each person in each of the different groups shared what they would like prayer for with the leader who then prayed for each person in the group.

Prayer partners: We both coordinated and encouraged people to find a person to pray with regularly. This will be reviewed by the pair after a few months and then they could potentially get a new partner or remain with the one they have.

Weave prayer into different parts of our gatherings - we have opportunities to pray with 2 or 3 in service, use responsive and structured prayers, plus a prayer space at end of the service.

Our intention was to encourage prayer as “the way we do things around here!” When we catch up with anyone formally or informally we look for opportunities to pray together. **“Can I pray for you?”**

Teaching series on prayer - We made it a practical series and not just about the theology of prayer! We identified paper based and online resources people could use and left them for people to take with them.

We encouraged the use of Bible and Prayer Apps - such as **YouVersion Bible and Lectio 365**







Holy Here is an invitation to city transformation as we follow Jesus and pray
