LOCATION: Hybrid, nationwide with proximity to a good airport.

WHO YOU WOULD WORK FOR: Christian Community Churches of NZ

Purpose (Who we are): We are a movement of independent local churches, and the camps and national ministries that support them, working together to point people to Jesus, through the gospel, from the Bible.

Our Mission (What we do): We invite churches to work together to make disciples, plant and renew churches, and develop leaders.

Vision: As part of the body of Christ, we are trusting God to see:

- The gospel for every person
- A church for every community
- Leaders for every church

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

To see CCCNZ/OBH churches working together to point youth and young adults to Jesus through the gospel from the Bible, by resourcing, supporting, encouraging and equipping youth and young adult leaders in partnership with their local church leadership.

The following categories outline what the role could include; however, the final job description would be developed in conversation with the successful candidate acknowledging their strengths and experience.

WHAT YOU WOULD DO:

National Engagement: As the Youth & Young Adults National Enabler, you will serve as the link between the local CCCNZ/Open Brethren Heritage youth leaders and CCCNZ, ensuring that youth leaders and pastors across the country have support and encouragement in their ministry.

Leadership Development: Leadership Development is a significant part of CCCNZ's purpose. In this role you would help create a Leadership Development Process and work with our Children & Family Ministries Enabler to develop and deliver events which aim to grow biblically, theologically, and spiritually formed youth and young adult ministry leaders.

First and Next Training: To deliver Leadership Development, CCCNZ currently offers leadership retreats across the country for youth and young adults aimed at helping raise the next generation of leaders and disciple makers.

Easter Camp Support: CCCNZ helps support several Easter Camps across the country each year, part of the National Enabler role is help facilitate and resource these camps to run effectively as they engage young people with the gospel.

Enablers Team Involvement: As part of a wider enablers team, you will take part in strategic planning meetings while offering support and encouragement to regions.



Working towards the CCCNZ strategic vision: As the Youth & Youth Adult National Enabler, you would support church evangelism and mission, encourage church planting and revitalisation opportunities within their regions, and help engage leaders in CCCNZ leadership development initiatives.

Resource Library: As part of our growing resources for local churches, you will help create and point churches to youth and young adult resources in our Resource Library.

THE SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE, AND EXPERIENCE YOU'LL NEED:

- Leadership – the ability to inspire and engage people in the vision and mission of CCCNZ.
- Experience leading in complex relational environments, with strengths in building trust.
- Youth or Young Adult ministry experience and leadership development in a local church context.
- Experience working at a national or regional level.
- Vision casting, strategy development, change management and delivery experience.
- Ability to work as a strong team player in a supportive team environment.
- High level of verbal and written communication standards, skills, and experience.
- Strong personal spiritual growth and character, fitting with a national Christian leadership role.
- A commitment to harmonious relationships with Christians of all denominations and cultures, recognising the desire expressed in the CCCNZ Trust Deed, that these relationships are 'informed by a thoughtful appreciation of Te Tiriti o Waitangi.'¹
- Knowledge and appreciation of CCCNZ/Open Brethren movement and history.
- Strong and mature theological formation which is aligned with the CCCNZ/Open Brethren theology and practice.
- Ability to travel nationally.
